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Review Rescinded on Periodontal Soft Tissue Graft Procedures

The procedure codes involved are D4270, D4271, D4273, D4275, and D4276.

Northeast Delta Dental has a responsibility to our purchasing groups and individual subscribers to ensure payments to dentists are consistent with current ADA code descriptions and Delta Dental processing policies. Clinical review of the claims for these procedures has shown that dentists are correctly coding the claims and complying with Northeast Delta Dental's processing policies.

Update on Health Care Reform

Nationally, Delta Dental Plans Association (DDPA) is closely following the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) implementation process, from the development of exchanges to the formulation of plan designs.

Attorney Ken Robinson, Northeast Delta Dental's General Counsel, and I communicate with DDPA regularly. We're monitoring the implementation of the critical federal regulations on the details of the law, including the required pediatric dental benefits portions of the essential benefits mandated by the law.

Most of the federal health care reform action will now take place with the agencies, primarily Health and Human Services, writing the detailed regulations. We're also keeping abreast of the ongoing legal and political challenges, which include several pending lawsuits and the 2012 presidential election nationally, and legislative activity addressing new health care reform requirements in Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont.

Oral Surgery Review

Effective November 1, 2011, Northeast Delta Dental began conducting a survey of claims for surgical extractions and impactions. We are conducting this review because our consultant review process has revealed that miscoding of oral surgery claims has become very common.

Our dental consultants believe much of the miscoding is probably attributable to misunderstanding the codes rather than to intentional abuse. We, therefore, view this process as being predominantly educational rather than punitive.

Our intent is to ensure that our providers understand and properly use 2011-2012 ADA Current Dental Terminology (CDT) codes for surgical extractions when submitting claims. We plan to continue this review only as long as required to gather more accurate data on use of surgical codes and to provide guidance on using them appropriately. We realize that this imposes some inconvenience on our providers and their office staff and wish to bring this process to a close as quickly as possible.

Dental Clinic Returns To Machias
